An exciting new way to explore the natural beauty of the Richmond Valley. This section of the Northern Rivers Rail Trail from Casino to Bentley will begin construction in 2022.

WHAT IS IT?

The Northern Rivers Rail Trail is a new walking and cycling trail that will connect the Tweed Valley with Byron Shire, Lismore and Casino, transforming a former rail corridor into the region's newest must-do experience for visitors and locals.

When completed, it will traverse 132km of some of the winding its way through scenic villages and towns, rail tunnels and historic bridges.

The trail will be constructed in four stages as funding allows, each delivered separately by the four local councils - Tweed Shire, Byron Shire, Lismore City and Richmond Valley.

CASINO - BENTLEY 13 4KM

The 13.4km stage will connect the historic Casino Rail Primex Site, Naughton's Gap tunnel, and Bentley Road. This project will help deliver a world-class recreational asset to the Richmond Valley, which will significantly support the local community in Casino and surrounds and generate positive environmental outcomes along the rail corridor.


